The Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences has as its aim to promote the sciences and strengthen their influence in society.

Announcement

The Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences is a party to agreements on research exchange covering stays of three weeks to six months in Japan, for studies and/or research in natural sciences, mathematics, medicine and humanities. The Academy pays travel costs from the home country to the host country and back, while the host higher education institution pays the costs of accommodation and travel in the country visited, and also a daily sum in the local currency for food and personal expenses.

The applicant must have a PhD. Both short study visits and long research stays may be considered. Applications relating solely to attendance at symposia and conferences are not approved. On the other hand, an award may be made for a combination of conference participation and a study visit. The journey must start during the period from 1 September 2012 to 31 March 2013. No award is granted to an applicant who has already received such an award over the past three years.

Application

The application must be made on a special form. This form can be downloaded below, in Word and PDF, during the application period. The Word form may be filled in on the screen and the PDF form is filled in manually on a printout. The PDF form can be viewed and printed out with the Adobe Reader program (version 4 or later), which may be downloaded free of charge from the Adobe website (www.adobe.se).

Eight copies of the form must be filled in, in English. It should then be signed and six (6) copies, stapled together, along with the annexes, should be sent to the address below. An account of the desired programme for the visit, in as much detail as possible, should be provided.

Closing date for applications: 2 April 2012.
