Announcement

The Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences will annually, during a ten-year period starting 2011, offer funding to support internationalisation and scientific renewal at the Sven Lovén Centre for Marine Sciences (SLC).

Funds can be used to cover:

- sabbatical visits to SLC for up to three months
- post-doctoral fellows at SLC for up to 12 months (not salary and per diem)
- international graduate schools at SLC
- travel and per diem costs for graduate students at SLC for up to three months

Available funding for 2013: Will be announced in September 2012.

Application

A link to the application site is provided below. In the on-line system, the user can create an account, enter personal particulars and upload the requisite attachments in electronic form.

Attachments

1. Project description (maximum 3 pages)
2. Invitation from the intended collaborator at the Sven Lovén Centre for Marine Sciences
3. Estimated costs for the stay at SLC, approved by the management of the centre. [Link to the price list of SLC \(in Swedish\)](#). Budget for approval shall be provided to the SLC manager **no later than 31 October 2012**. E-mail address katarina.abrahamsson@gu.se. The approved budget shall be submitted to the on-line application.

The documents above are to be attached on page eight (8) in the on-line application form. Note that the documents number 2 and 3 both shall be included in the attachment entitled "Other document".

Finally, the user must print out a form, sign it, get it attested by the supervisor or head of the institute concerned and send it to the address specified on the form. Please note that you must submit the application electronically first, before you can print out the form for signing.
