



Information regarding the processing of academy members' personal data

Kungl. Vetenskapsakademien (The Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences) (“**KVA**”), corporate identity number 262000-1129 (“we”, “us” and “our”), with postal address Box 50005, 104 05 STOCKHOLM, is the data controller for the processing of your personal data and is dedicated to the protection of your personal integrity. Our ambition is to always protect your personal data in the best way possible and to comply with all applicable data protection laws and regulations. Through this privacy policy we wish to inform you of how we process your personal data in your role as a member of KVA.

Categories of personal data we process concerning you

The personal data we process concerning you are contact details, birth date, election date, member number, sex, nationality, information regarding professional and scientific career, information regarding publications, information concerning potential commissions of trust within KVA, received prizes and awards, contact details to relatives, bank details, photos, videos and phonograms, allergies and special dietary requirements.

Purpose and legal basis for processing your personal data

We process your personal data for the following purposes if you have given us your consent:

- Internal and external publication of the academy member's picture and contact details under certain circumstances.
- Handling allergy and special dietary requirements.

We process your personal data for the following purposes on the basis of a legitimate interest:

- Communication with academy members (e.g. invitations to meetings).
- Administering KVA's organisational structure.
- Economic communication (e.g. paying travel expenses).
- Keeping information regarding academy members for scientific and historical research purposes.
- Transfers to associated organisations and partners (e.g. Nobel Foundation or WWF).
- Internal statistics and reporting of importance for KVA's operations.
- Internal and external publication of the academy member's picture and contact details under certain circumstances.



Our or a third party's legitimate interest of processing your personal data on the basis of a balance of interests is to ensure that KVA's operations and the work of academy members function in the best way possible and that the operational goals of KVA can be fulfilled.

Who may get access to your personal data?

Your personal data may be shared with parties that process personal data on our behalf, i.e. data processors. For instance, our IT and system providers, banks, accounting firms, insurance companies, restaurants and event companies may get access to your personal data.

Your personal data may also be shared with the following parties that are independent data controllers when processing your personal data:

- Public authorities (e.g.. the Swedish Research Council)
- Partners (e.g. Nobel Foundation or WWF)
- Other members of KVA.
- Mass media.
- Travelling agencies.

Transfers of personal data to third countries

As a general rule, we and our suppliers and partners process your personal data only within the EU/EEA. In cases where personal data are processed outside the EU/EEA, we base the processing either on a decision from the European Commission that the relevant third country ensures an adequate level of protection, or appropriate safeguards, e.g. standard data protection clauses, binding corporate rules, or Privacy Shield, to ensure that your rights are protected. If you wish to receive a copy of the safeguards taken by us or information regarding where these safeguards have been made available, please contact us by using the contact details stated below.

How long do we keep your personal data?

We never process your personal data for a longer period than is allowed by applicable law, regulation, case law or authority decision. Personal data that we process on the basis of a balance of interests are normally processed for the period that is necessary for fulfilling the purposes of the processing. For this reason, some personal data are deleted when you end your commission of trust within KVA. To comply with legal obligations or because you have given your consent, we may keep your personal data for a longer period. Some personal data will also be kept for a longer period after you have ended your commission of trust within KVA for scientific and historical research purposes.



Your rights

In accordance with applicable data protection regulation, you have the right to request access to the personal data we process regarding you, and have the right to request rectification of your personal data.

Under certain circumstances, you are entitled to request the erasure of your personal data or restriction of the processing of your personal data or object towards our processing of your personal data. Furthermore, under certain circumstances, you are entitled to receive the personal data concerning you in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and have the right to transmit the personal data to another data controller.

You have the right to fully or partially withdraw a given consent regarding the processing of personal data at any time, with effect from the time of the withdrawal.

If you have any complaints regarding our processing of your personal data you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Swedish supervisory authority Datatillsynen or any other competent supervisory authority that monitors enterprises' processing of personal data.
